**WHEREAS**, at its meeting on May 21, 2026, the Civil Service Commission adopted the following amendments to the Classified Pay Plan (Fire).

In accordance with Article X, Section 10 of the Constitution of Louisiana, this agency is submitting for Council approval the following amendments to the Classified Pay Plan as adopted by the Civil Service Commission at its meeting of May 21, 2026, as outlined below:

**New Classifications:**

| Class Code | New Classification                             | Grade/Step<br>Hiring Rate |
|------------|------------------------------------------------|---------------------------|
| C7260      | Firefighter<br>(Transitional Duty)             | 57/40 \$45,734            |
| C7261      | Fire Apparatus Operator<br>(Transitional Duty) | 61/40 \$50,513            |
| C7262      | Fire Captain<br>(Transitional Duty)            | 67/40 \$58,633            |

At the request of the Fire Department, the Commission approved the creation of the aforementioned Fire Transitional Duty classifications. It is the intent of these positions to provide medically restricted fire service employees the opportunity to remain gainfully employed while recovering from an on-duty or non-duty injury or medical condition. Assignments are structured to comply with physician-imposed restrictions and do not involve emergency response or fire suppression duties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Administrative Office has certified that funds are available to implement the above proposed amendments to the Classified Pay Plan; **NOW THEREFORE**

**BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS,** That in accordance with Article X, Section 10 of the Constitution of Louisiana, the amendments to the Classified Pay Plan are approved to be effective June 21, 2026.
