### Operational Technology Systems Series

At the request of the Sewerage and Water Board, the Commission approved the creation of the aforementioned Operational Technology series. Work of positions in this series provide specialized support for industrial control systems, programmable logic controllers, telemetry, instrumentation and automation technologies. Work also includes maintaining and configuring cyber-physical systems that require consistent standards, documentation, and lifecycle practices.
