**AN ORDINANCE** to amend and reordain Article 18 of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. 4264 M.C.S., as amended by Ordinance No. 26,413 M.C.S. and subsequent amendments) to establish the “Fairgrounds Overlay District”, including the area upon which the Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots currently sits, generally bounded by Gentilly Boulevard, Belfort Street/Avenue, Trafalgar Street, Desaix Boulevard, St. Louis Cemetery No. 3, St. Vincent Street, Verna Court, and Fortin Street, to maintain current and historical fairground and racetrack opportunities; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

**WHEREAS, Zoning Docket Number 50/25** was initiated by City Council Motion No. M-25-396 and referred to the City Planning Commission; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Planning Commission held a public hearing on this zoning petition and recommended approval of the requested text amendment in its report to the City Council dated November 12, 2025, presented in **Zoning Docket Number 50/25**; and

**WHEREAS,** the changes were deemed necessary and in the best interest of the City of New Orleans and the request was approved by City Council, as stated in Motion Number M-25-646 of the Council of the City of New Orleans on December 18, 2025; and

1           **SECTION 1. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY**  
2   **ORDAINS,** That Article 18 of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. 4264

3 M.C.S., as amended by Ordinance No. 26,413 M.C.S. and subsequent amendments), be, and is  
4 hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

9 **18.2.BB – PURPOSE OF THE FAIRGROUNDS OVERLAY DISTRICT**

10 **The purpose of the Fairgrounds Overlay District is to preserve the historic use of the Fair**  
11 **Grounds Race Course & Slots for the benefit of the neighborhood and for the city at large**  
12 **and ensure appropriate coordination of any residential development efforts. The purpose is**  
13 **not to deprive the property of existing property rights or to prevent the expansion of the**  
14 **facility through the processes established by this ordinance.**

15 **Should the Fair Grounds cease operations and be redeveloped for residential use not**  
16 **associated with racetrack operations, such residential development is generally limited to**  
17 **the planned development process to ensure redevelopment efforts consider site design,**  
18 **infrastructure improvements, and public facilities.**

25 **Verna Court, and Fortin Street.**

Such expansion may include the expansion or addition of ancillary use that support the racetrack's operation, including but not limited to racetrack, casino, sports book, off track betting parlor, ticketing operations, office/professional workspaces, non-profit offices, governmental offices, group sales/meeting facilities, horse stalling/equine husbandry, equine training, racetrack maintenance, mechanics shop, feed store, museum, retail, tv production, storage, ~~multi-family housing~~, single family housing, transient lodging, restaurants, concessions/snack bars and bars.
