AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of New Orleans to enter into Amendment No. 1 to an existing Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between the City of New Orleans (the “City”) and The National World War II Museum, Inc., to extend the term by one year, for the public purpose of improving pedestrian walkways along Andrew Higgins Drive, including enhancements within part of the Museum Operations Corridor, for the benefit of and enjoyment by New Orleans citizens and visitors and to encourage Convention Center participants to explore the historic Warehouse District and the Museum Operations Corridor in the City of New Orleans; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority contained in Article 7, Section 14(C) of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental thereto, the State of Louisiana and its political subdivisions, including the City, may enter into cooperative endeavors with each other, or with any public or private corporation or individual; and further pursuant to Section 9-314 of the Home Rule Charter of the City of New Orleans, the City may enter into cooperative endeavors with any public or private association, corporation, or individual for activities in support of economic growth and other public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City and The National World War II Museum, Inc. desire to enter into an Amendment No. 1 to the existing cooperative endeavor agreement in order to accomplish the valued public purpose of improving pedestrian walkways along Andrew Higgins Drive, including enhancements within part of the Museum Operations Corridor, for the benefit of and enjoyment by New Orleans citizens and visitors and to encourage Convention Center participants to explore the historic Warehouse District and the Museum Operations Corridor in the City of New Orleans;
NOW THEREFORE

1 **SECTION I. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY**
2 **ORDAINS**, That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of New Orleans, is hereby authorized to enter
3 into the attached Amendment No. 1 to the existing cooperative endeavor agreement with The
4 National World War II Museum, Inc. through September 14, 2026, for the public purpose of
5 improving pedestrian walkways along Andrew Higgins Drive, including enhancements within part
6 of the Museum Operations Corridor, for the benefit of and enjoyment by New Orleans citizens and
7 visitors and to encourage Convention Center participants to explore the historic Warehouse
8 District and the Museum Operations Corridor in the City of New Orleans.

1 **SECTION 2.** That said amendment to the cooperative endeavor agreement is attached to
2 this ordinance as “Exhibit A” and incorporated and made a part hereof.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS

AND

THE NATIONAL WORLD WAR II MUSEUM, INC.

ANDREW HIGGINS STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT (the “**Amendment**”) is entered into by and between the City of New Orleans, represented by LaToya Cantrell, Mayor (the “**City**”), and The National WWII Museum, represented by Stephen Watson, President and CEO (the “**Museum**”). The City and the Museum are sometimes each referred to as the “**Party**,” and collectively, as the “**Parties**.” The Amendment is effective as of September 15, 2025 (the “**Effective Date**”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and the Museum are parties to a cooperative endeavor agreement dated effective January 24, 2024 (the “**Agreement**”) for the purpose of improving pedestrian walkways along Andrew Higgins Drive, including enhancements within part of the Museum Operations Corridor, for the benefit of and enjoyment by New Orleans citizens and visitors and to encourage Convention Center participants to explore the historic Warehouse District and the Museum Operations Corridor;

WHEREAS, the City and the Museum, each having the authority to do so, desire to enter this Amendment to extend the term for continuity of services;

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the City and the Museum amend the Agreement as follows:

A. EXTENSION. The term of the Agreement is extended for one (1) additional year from September 15, 2025, through September 14, 2026.

B. CONVICTED FELON STATEMENT. The Museum swears that it complies with City Code Section § 2-8(c). No Museum principal, member, or officer has, within the preceding five years, been convicted of, or pled guilty to, a felony under state or federal statutes for embezzlement, theft of public funds, bribery, or falsification or destruction of public records.

C. NON-SOLICITATION STATEMENT. The Museum swears that it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for it, to solicit or secure this Amendment. The Museum has not paid or agreed to pay any person, other than a bona fide employee working for it, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from this Amendment.

D. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE AND DELIVERY. The Parties agree that a manually signed copy of this Amendment and any other document(s) attached to this Amendment delivered by facsimile, email, or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original signed copy of this Amendment. No legally binding obligation shall be created with respect to a Party until such Party has delivered or caused to be delivered a manually signed copy of this Amendment.

E. PRIOR TERMS BINDING. Except as otherwise provided by this Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
