SECTION 1. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY ORDAINS, That section 70-415.342 of the Code of the City of New Orleans, Louisiana is amended to read as follows: "Chapter 70 – FINANCE * * * ARTICLE III. – FUNDS * * * DIVISION 54. –NEW ORLEANS HOUSING TRUST FUND * * * Sec. 70-415.342. –Housing trust fund advisory committee. * * * (b) Composition. The advisory committee shall have a total of seven members, all of whom shall be electors of and domiciled in the city and shall possess experience in one or more of the following areas: architecture and preservation, community development, community and housing development finance, economic development, fair housing, populations with special needs, smart

growth, sustainable development, and local and regional housing and neighborhood data. The
