Sec. 162-745. - Meter fare for taxicabs and DFTs.

The taxicab or DFT meter fare shall be \$3.50, which shall entitle the passenger to be transported the first one-eighth mile, and the total meter fare shall include an additional \$0.30 for each additional one-eighth mile, or incompletd fraction thereof that the passenger is transported; provided that whatever [whenever] the speed of the taxicab or DFT is less than the rate of one-eighth mile per 40 seconds, an additional \$0.30 shall accrue for each 40 second interval therein. There shall be an additional charge of \$1.00 per passenger after one passenger on all regular taxi or DFT trips.

(a) ~~An additional gasoline surcharge of \$1.00 per each completed trip shall be authorized until December 31, 2022.~~ **An additional gasoline surcharge of \$1.00 per each completed trip shall be authorized until December 31, 2027.**

(b) All taxicabs and DFTs are required to post in plain sight in the interior of the vehicle notice to passengers of a \$1.00 gasoline surcharge for each completed trip subject to design specifications approved by the director of the department of public works pursuant to section 162-743.
