A **RESOLUTION** endorsing and supporting House Bill 573 by Representative Stephanie Hilferty, relative to the governance, oversight, and accountability of the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans, and urging its favorable passage by the Louisiana Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans is responsible for the construction, control, maintenance, and operation of the public water, sewerage, and drainage systems serving the people of New Orleans; and

WHEREAS, under current state law, the Board is composed of the Mayor of New Orleans, the chair of the Council's Public Works, Sanitation and Environment Committee or a qualified designee, two members of the Board of Liquidation, City Debt, and seven citizen members appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council exercises important oversight over the Sewerage and Water Board, including authority related to rates, billing-policy procedures, investigations, and certain approvals tied to Board operations and financing; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that New Orleans residents deserve a governance structure for the Sewerage and Water Board that is more transparent, more accountable, and more responsive to local needs; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 573 by Representative Stephanie Hilferty strengthens local accountability by allowing the Council to prescribe board-member rules by ordinance and require Council approval of rates, annual operating budgets, capital budgets and plans, governance and billing policies, contracts, and the election of the executive director and hiring of board employees, while preserving existing legal and financial obligations of the Board; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That the Council hereby endorses and supports House Bill 573 by Representative Stephanie Hilferty, together with any amendments consistent with its purpose of strengthening local accountability,

modernizing governance, preserving legal and financial obligations, and improving service to the people of New Orleans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Council urges the Louisiana Legislature to consider House Bill 573 that enacts reforms that provide the City of New Orleans with durable local tools to improve oversight, governance, and performance at the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans.
