Dear Clerk of Council:

Pursuant to the Financing Order adopted in Resolution R-15-193 on May 14, 2015 in regard to the *Application of Entergy New Orleans, Inc. for Certification of Costs Related to Hurricane Isaac, and for Related Relief and Application of Entergy Louisiana, LLC for Recovery in Rates of Costs Related to Hurricane Isaac, and Related Relief in the Fifteenth Ward of New Orleans (Algiers), Docket No. UD-14-01 (Phase II)* (the “Financing Order”), Entergy New Orleans, Inc. (“ENO”) as Servicer of the Storm Recovery Bonds or any successor Servicer on behalf of the trustee as assignee of the SPE shall ENO shall apply annually for a mandatory periodic revision of the Rate Adjustment shown in Attachment “A” to the Securitized Storm Cost Offset Rider – SSCO (“Rider SSCO”). Using the formula approved by the Council in the Financing Order, this revision filing modifies the variables used in the formula and provides the resulting revision to the Rider SSCO Rate Adjustment, which is expressed as a percentage of base rate revenues and calculated in accordance with the Financing Order. The assumptions underlying the current Rider SSCO Rate Adjustment were submitted by ENO in a previous filing dated July 15, 2025.

Accordingly, enclosed for your further handling is a copy of the annual Revision to the Rate Adjustment shown in Attachment “A” to the Rider SSCO.

The following materials are provided with this letter:

SECURITIZED STORM COST OFFSET RIDER - SSCO

I. APPLICABILITY

This rider is applicable under the regular terms and conditions of Entergy New Orleans, LLC to all customers served under any retail electric rate schedule* and/or rider schedule* or Special Contract Rates pursuant to the Council of the City of New Orleans (the "Council") orders in Docket No. UD-14-01.

II. NET MONTHLY RATE

There shall be added to each monthly bill for electric service an adjustment as approved by the Council. Each Net Monthly Bill shall be adjusted by the appropriate rate shown in Attachment A.

III. ANNUAL REVIEW AND FILING

Beginning in 2016 and concurrent with the filing for the first adjustment to Rider SSCR, ENOL shall file a revised Attachment A containing a revised Rate Adjustment. The revised Rate Adjustment shall become effective for bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle for the month of August of the filing year and shall then remain in effect until changed pursuant to the provisions of this Rider.
