BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That **JILL SUSSMAN's** appeal of the Historic District Landmarks Commission's (HDLC) decision regarding the application for the retention of the installation of inappropriate windows at a contributing rated, two-story, two-family residential building without a Certificate of Appropriateness located at **1413 Columbus Street, Apartments A and B,** whereby the HDLC denied the application as to the windows labeled 1-6 in the staff report, and approved the application as to the windows labeled 7 and 8, provided that full screens be added, is granted;

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, That the decision of the HDLC as to the windows labeled 1, 2, and 6 in the staff report is hereby affirmed, and, the decision of the HDLC as to the windows labeled 3, 4, 5, 7, and 8 in the staff report is hereby modified to permit the retention of the windows without the proviso that wood screens be installed; and

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, That the Clerk of Council shall forward copies of this motion to all affected departments, including the HDLC and the Department of Safety and Permits.
