AN ORDINANCE to amend and re-ordain Ordinance No. 30,532 M.C.S., entitled “An Ordinance Providing a Capital Budget for the Year 2026”, to effect the following change to the 2026 Capital Budget: to appropriate funds to the Chief Administrative Office, the Department of Parks and Parkways, the Department of Property Management, the Department of Public Works, the New Orleans Mosquito, Termite and Rodent Control Board, the New Orleans Police Department, and the New Orleans Recreation Commission; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

SECTION I. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY

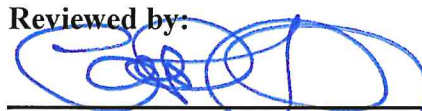
