

Dear Eric McCutcheon:

This letter confirms the actions of the New Orleans Historic District Landmarks Commission at its meeting of Wednesday, June 3, 2026, concerning your application for the following work: Retention of the demolition of the historic materials on the primary facade of a Contributing rated, raised-basement, single-family residential building.

At that time the Commission voted to:

Deny the application for retention of demolition involving more than 25% of the historic materials on the primary facade. The primary façade must be restored to its appearance prior to the removal of the double-hung windows, pair of entry doors, and transom. If the original material cannot be reinstalled, the new doors and windows must match the existing in size, shape, configuration, type, operation, materials, muntin pattern, dimension, profiles, relief, and detailing. The proposed door and window specifications and installation details are to be submitted to the HDLC for review and approval prior to purchase and installation.

If you wish to appeal the Commission's decision to the City Council, you must submit a written request for appeal to both the HDLC and the Clerk of Council at clerkofcouncil@nola.gov. Alternatively, written requests may be delivered to the Clerk of Council, City Hall, Room 1E09, New Orleans, LA 70112. **All requests must be submitted within ten (10) calendar days of the Commission meeting.** Please be sure to include a copy of this letter with your request.
