AN ORDINANCE to ratify and confirm the temporary waiver of certain fees, permit fees, and requirements within and around First Grace Methodist Church located at 3401 Canal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, in conjunction with the NOLAKEYS 5th Annual Stop the Violence Youth Bike Ride and School Supply Giveaway event on Saturday, August 2, 2025 at 4:00p.m.; to ratify and confirm the duration and boundaries of said waiver; and to provide otherwise with respect thereto.

1 **SECTION 1. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY**
2 **ORDAINS**, That the entirety of the Special Event Occupancy (Non-Profit) Fee, Revenue Non-
3 Profit Parade Permit Fee, and Non-Profit Parade Revenue Music for Entertainment No Admission
4 Fee shall be and have been waived for events and activities of the NOLAKEYS 5th Annual Stop
5 the Violence Youth Bike Ride and School Supply Giveaway event on Saturday, August 2, 2025,
6 within and around First Grace United Methodist Church located at 3401 Canal Street, New
7 Orleans, Louisiana (the “NOLAKEYS event”). The fee waiver authorized by this section shall not
8 and have not included any direct costs to the city.

1 **SECTION 2.** That the provisions of Section 1 above shall be and have been applied only
2 to those persons engaged in activities in conjunction with the NOLAKEYS event which shall be
3 and have been specified in writing, and the names of such persons shall be and have been filed

4 along with a schedule of approved activities by the chairperson of the NOLAKEYS event no later
5 than ten days prior to the event.

1 **SECTION 3.** That the chairperson of the NOLAKEYS event shall add and has added the
2 City of New Orleans as insured in the insurance policy held by the chairperson of the NOLAKEYS
3 event for the duration of its activities stated herein.

1 **SECTION 4.** That this ordinance shall be construed to have superseded and waived the
2 provisions of any moratorium or other ordinance that may have been applicable.
