WHEREAS, at its meeting on September 12, 2025, the Civil Service Commission adopted the following amendment to the Classified Pay Plan (Property Management).

In accordance with Article X, Section 10 of the Constitution of Louisiana, this agency is submitting for Council approval the following amendment to the Classified Pay Plan as adopted by the Civil Service Commission at its meeting of September 12, 2025 as outlined below:

New Classification:

Class Code	New Classification	Grade/Step	Hiring Rate	FLSA Status
C8607	Cemetery Programs Superintendent	86/25	\$78,024	Exempt

At the request of the Department of Property Management, the Civil Service Commission approved the aforementioned new classification that would involve the overall management and operations of city-owned cemeteries. Work includes oversight of cemetery landscaping, grounds maintenance, security, burial procedures, records maintenance and the allocation of burial spaces. Work also includes responsibility for developing and delivering a range of programming and services that identifies, documents, and supports the preservation and protection of city cemeteries; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Administrative Office has certified that funds are available to implement the above proposed amendment to the Classified Pay Plan; **NOW THEREFORE**

BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That in accordance with Article X, Section 10 of the Constitution of Louisiana, the amendment to the Classified Pay Plan is approved to be effective February 1, 2026.
