BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That Rules 15 and 15.1 of the Council Rules are hereby suspended; and

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, That regarding the Council's appointment of councilmembers to various boards, commissions and agencies, the following appointments are hereby made:

1. In accordance with Section 4-2201 of the Home Rule Charter, Councilmember **Aimee McCarron** is hereby appointed to the New Orleans **Mosquito and Termite Control Board**.
2. In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation of the New Orleans Museum of Art, Councilmember **J. P. Morrell** is hereby appointed to the Board of the **New Orleans Museum of Art**.
3. In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation of the Municipal Yacht Harbor Management Corporation, Councilmembers **Matthew Willard** and **Aimee McCarron** are hereby appointed to the Board of Directors of the **Municipal Yacht Harbor Management Corporation**.
4. In accordance with Ord. No. 28,929 M.C.S, Councilmember **Eugene Green** is hereby appointed to the **Sandy Krasnoff New Orleans Criminal Justice Council**.
5. In accordance with City Code Section 2-263, Councilmember **Eugene Green** is hereby appointed to the **New Orleans Children and Youth Planning Board**.
6. In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation of the City Park Improvement Association, Councilmembers **Aimee McCarron** and **Jason Hughes** are hereby appointed to the Board of the **City Park Improvement Association**.
7. The Council's adoption of M-26-106 on March 12, 2026, appointing Councilmember **Matthew Willard** as its representative on the **Louisiana Police Jury Association** is hereby ratified and affirmed.

8. The Council's adoption of M-26-26 on January 12, 2026, appointing Councilmembers **Lesli Harris** and **J. P. Morrell** as the Council's voting and non-voting representatives on the **Revenue Estimating Conference** is hereby ratified and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, That for the information of the public, members of the Council serve ex-officio on various boards and commissions as follows:

1. In accordance with Sec. 5-101 of the Home Rule Charter, the two councilmembers-at-large serve ex-officio on the **Board of Liquidation, City Debt**.
2. In accordance with Sec. 4-1901 of the Home Rule Charter, the Council President as elected in accordance with Sec. 3-107 of the Charter and Council Rule 8, serves ex-officio on the **Board of City Trusts**.
3. In accordance with Sec. 118-46.1 of the City Code, the two councilmembers-at-large serve ex-officio on the **Regional Planning Commission**.
4. In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation of the **New Orleans Tourism & Cultural Fund** (formerly known as New Orleans Tourism Marketing Corporation), as amended, and approved pursuant to Ord. No. 28,339 M.C.S., the two councilmembers that represent the Vieux Carré (Councilmember **Freddie King**) and the area of the Downtown Development District (Councilmember **Lesli Harris**).
5. In accordance with Ord. No. 28,929 M.C.S., the two councilmembers-at-large serve as ex-officio on the **Sandy Krasnoff New Orleans Criminal Justice Council**.
6. In accordance with La. R.S. § 33:2740.27 and Ord. No. 21,282 M.C.S. the councilmember for District C, Councilmember **Freddie King**, serves ex-officio on the board of commissioners of the **Algiers Development District**.
7. In accordance with Sec. 2-319 of the City Code, the Council President as elected in accordance with Sec. 3-107 of the Home Rule Charter and Council Rule 8, serves ex-officio on the **New Orleans Recreation Development Commission**; by this motion Council President J. P. Morrell appoints **Councilmember Jason Hughes** to serve in his stead.

8. In accordance with the Articles of Incorporation and Ord. No. 27,239 M.C.S., the Council President as elected in accordance with Sec. 3-107 of the Home Rule Charter and Council Rule 8, serves ex-officio on the Board of Directors of the **New Orleans Building Corporation**.
9. In accordance with the Second Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of the New Orleans Building Corporation and Ord. No. 27,239 M.C.S., establishing that a district councilmember shall serve ex officio on the Board of Directors, rotating annually beginning with District C, followed by B, then A, then E, then D, that, beginning with Councilmember Jason Hughes, followed by Councilmember Freddie King, then Councilmember Lesli Harris, then Councilmember McCarron, serve ex-officio on the Board of Directors of the **New Orleans Building Corporation** for the years 2026, 2027, 2028, and 2029, respectively.
10. In accordance with La. R.S. § 33-4071, chair of the Public Works, Sanitation and Environment Committee, **Councilmember Jason Hughes**, serves ex-officio on the **Sewerage and Water Board**.
