My name is Kim Braud, I am a returning resident and business owner. I am submitting on behalf of my mother Beryl Jones who resides at 6617 Maumus Avenue in Algiers. I am submitting this written comment in support of thoughtful, rigorous study of the proposed rezoning in the Fifth Municipal District bounded by Behrman Place, Holiday Drive, General De Gaulle Drive, the Algiers Canal, and the former Brechtel Golf Course.</p> <p>Algiers deserves investment, quality businesses, and intentional growth. The CPC study being directed by Motion M-26-72 is the right process, but only if it asks the right questions. I am submitting this comment to put those questions on the official record at the outset of the study. This Council has already established the standard for how development in Algiers should be evaluated. The Lower Coast Algiers Impact Study, conducted by the City Planning Commission per Council Motion M-22-447, created a clear precedent: before rezoning moves forward in Algiers, relevant agencies must complete infrastructure assessments covering drainage, roads, fire response, police capacity, and utilities.</p>
