

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS
AND
BIG EASY LAW GROUP, LLC

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT is entered into by and between the Civil Service Commission of the City of New Orleans (“**Commission**”), represented by Chairperson Brittney Richardson, and Big Easy Law Group, LLC, represented by Jenny Abshier (“**Contractor**”). The Commission and the Contractor are sometimes referred to collectively as “**the Parties**.” This Amendment is effective as of **January 1, 2026**. (the “**Effective Date**”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2024, the Commission issued a Request for Qualifications seeking qualified attorneys to conduct hearings for the Civil Service Commission (the “**RFQ**”);

WHEREAS, the Contractor submitted a proposal dated March 27, 2024, and the Commission selected the Attorney to perform the professional legal services described in the RFQ;

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2025, the Parties and the President of the City Council executed a Professional Services Agreement to provide said services (the “**Agreement**”);

WHEREAS, the Commission and Contractor, each having authority to do so, desire to enter into this First Amendment to amend the term of the Agreement and the total compensation:

1. **Compensation.** The compensation described in Article IV, Section B of the Agreement, is amended to reflect a total amount of \$25,000 for the term beginning January 1, 2026, and ending December 31, 2026;
2. **Prior Terms Binding.** Except as otherwise provided in this Second Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Commission and the Contractor, through their duly authorized representatives, execute this Second Amendment.
